Student Expectations:

- 1. Students are expected to be present and prepared (present in the room, phones on silent, ready to work, scripts accessible, warmed up, etc.) for each rehearsal.
- 2. Students are expected to let the Director know as soon as possible if they are unable to attend rehearsal.
- 3. Students are expected to complete assigned work outside the scheduled rehearsals (memorizing lines, making notes in scripts, preparing choices for next rehearsal, reviewing blocking).
- 4. Students are expected to be on time and prepared for Q2Q and Dress Rehearsal days .
 - a. CAST A:
 - i. Tuesdays from September 19 November 14 from 6:00 9:00PM
 - ii. Tech Days: November 21 & 22 (tentative 6:00 10:00PM)
 - iii. Show Dates: November 25 & 26 (tentative 2:30PM & 7:30PM)
 - b. CAST B:
 - i. Thursdays from September 21 November 16 from 6:00 9:00PM
 - ii. Tech Days: November 23 & 24 (tentative 6:00 10:00PM)
 - iii. Show Dates: November 25 & 26 (tentative 2:30PM & 7:30PM)
- 5. Students are expected to be off book as soon as possible to allow for more physical explorations in the rehearsal process. Deadline: November 1.
- 6. Students are expected to come to rehearsal with offers/ideas for the character and scenes.
- 7. Students are expected to use any 'down time' in rehearsal to work on lines, character work, or work on scenes with a partner.
- 8. Students are expected to ask consent before initiating any physical touch in the rehearsal hall.
- 9. Students are expected to adhere to the Community Standards.
